"Let your light shine"

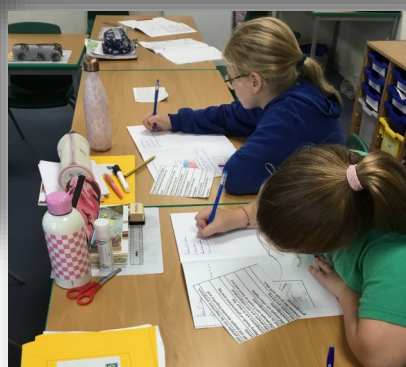
As we approach the halfway point for this half term, there has been a lot going on in school already and several new diary dates have been added to the newsletter so please take a look.

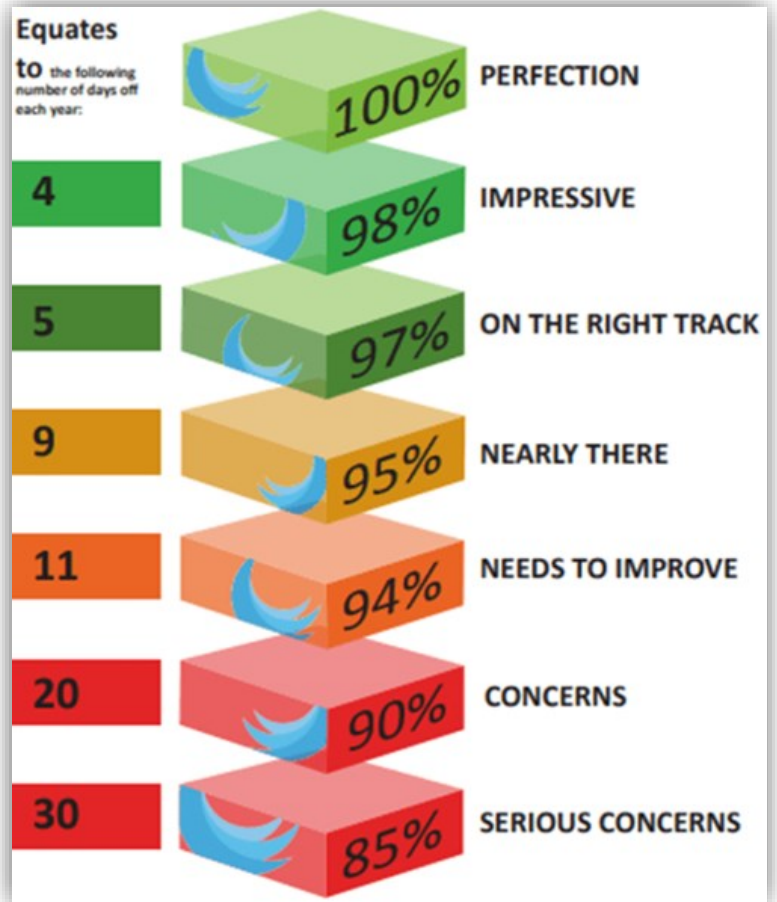

Get To School On Time Check List

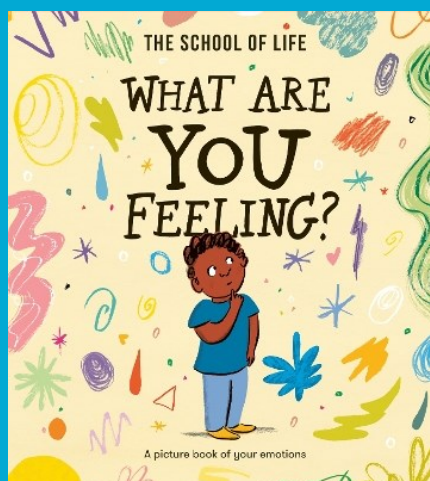
-  Pick out your outfit and lay it out.
