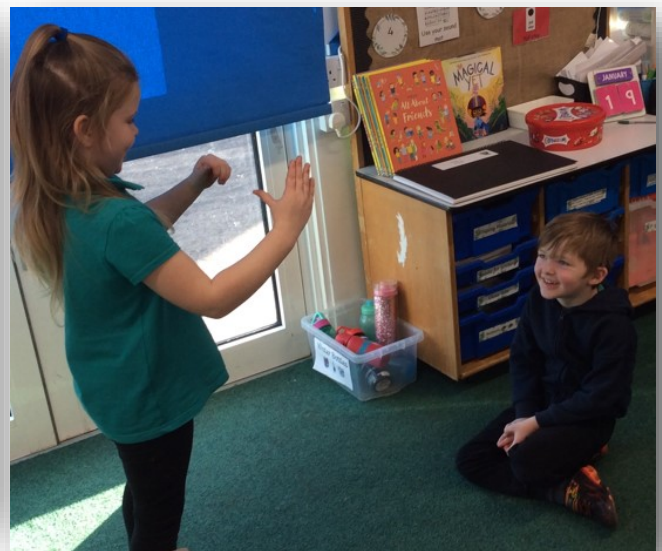
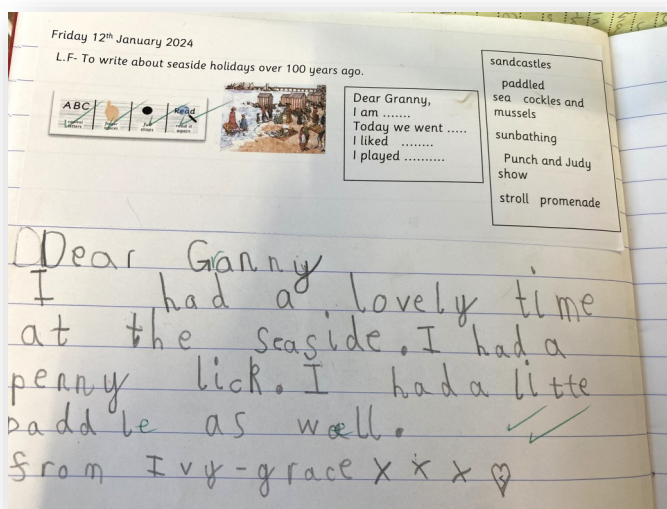
*"Let your light shine"*

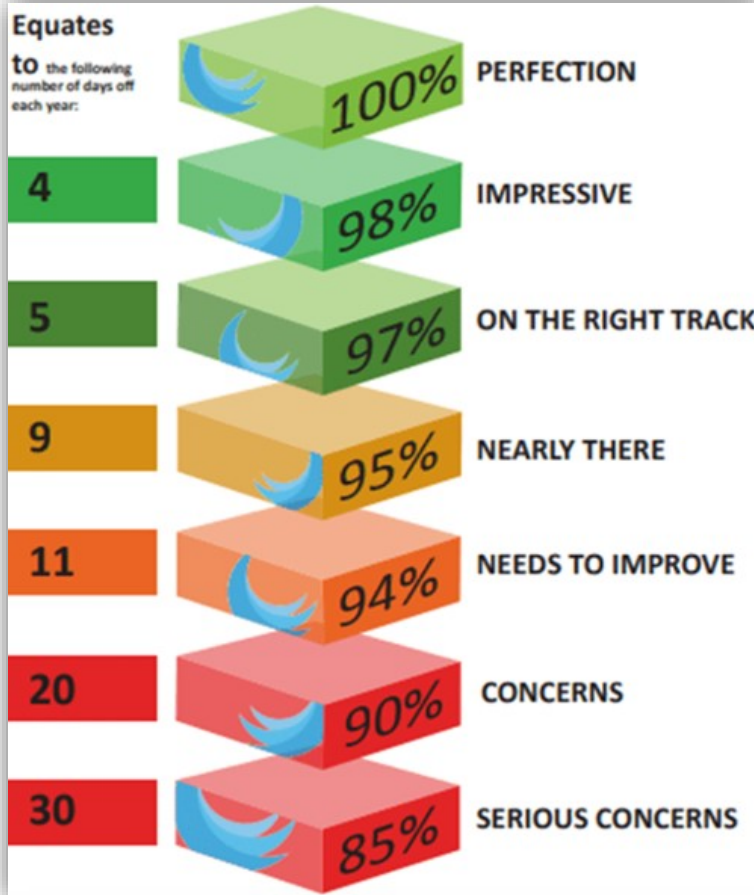

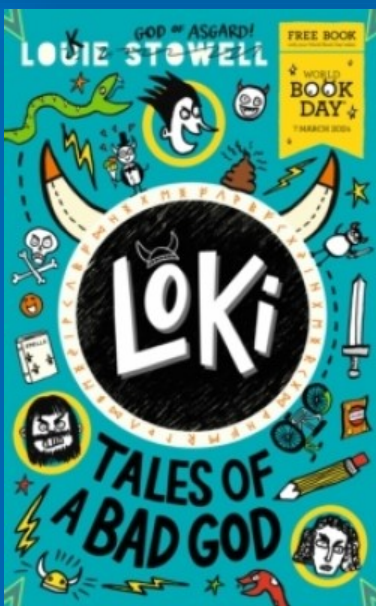

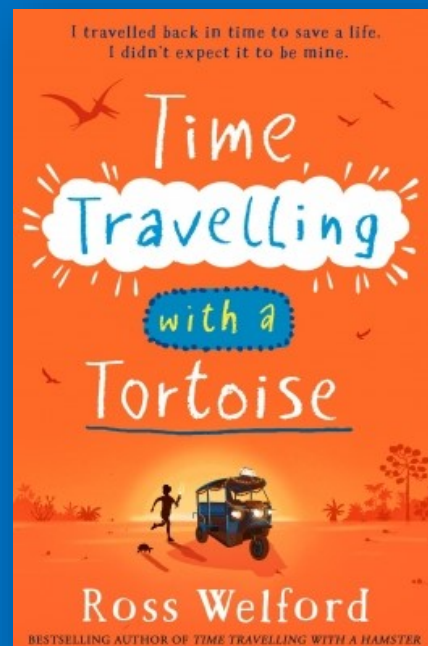
