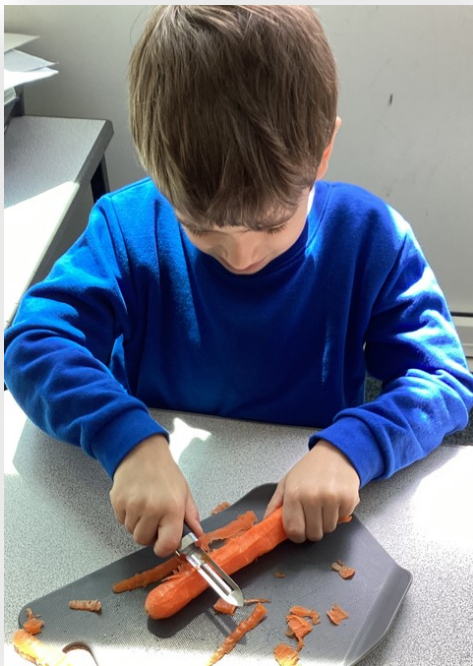

This week has been assessment week for all classes apart from Year 6. These results will be part of teachers' assessment of pupils and whether or not children have met the expectation for their age. We have a new format for reports this year and the information is taken directly from our new tracking system. These will be shared via the reports in July.

With assessment week comes DT week. Across the school there has been a variety of learning taking place, from cooking pasta bake, making dip to designing and sewing bags. The children have had a fantastic week and, as a school, it is wonderful to see the children experience school life beyond Maths and English.

Early Years children have been learning about boats, designing boats, discovering which materials float, putting pictures of boats in "oldest to newest" order and finally...boat building! For DT week, Year 2 began their unit on 'Moving Pictures'. They designed, made and evaluated their own moving pictures which incorporate moving mechanisms such as sliders and levers. They looked at some books with moving parts and then had a go at creating their own sliders.

Year 4 practised peeling and chopping fruit for their incredible crumbles. The smell was amazing!

Year 6 have been planning baking activities so they can contribute to the school fete. We are really looking forward to that!

Finally, Year 5 have been researching, designing and making cross-body bags and have really done a good job!

Zoe has raised money for charity before; here she is handing over £40 to Leamington Night Shelter.

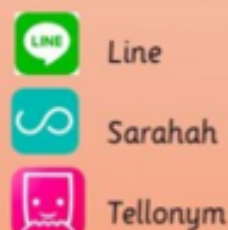

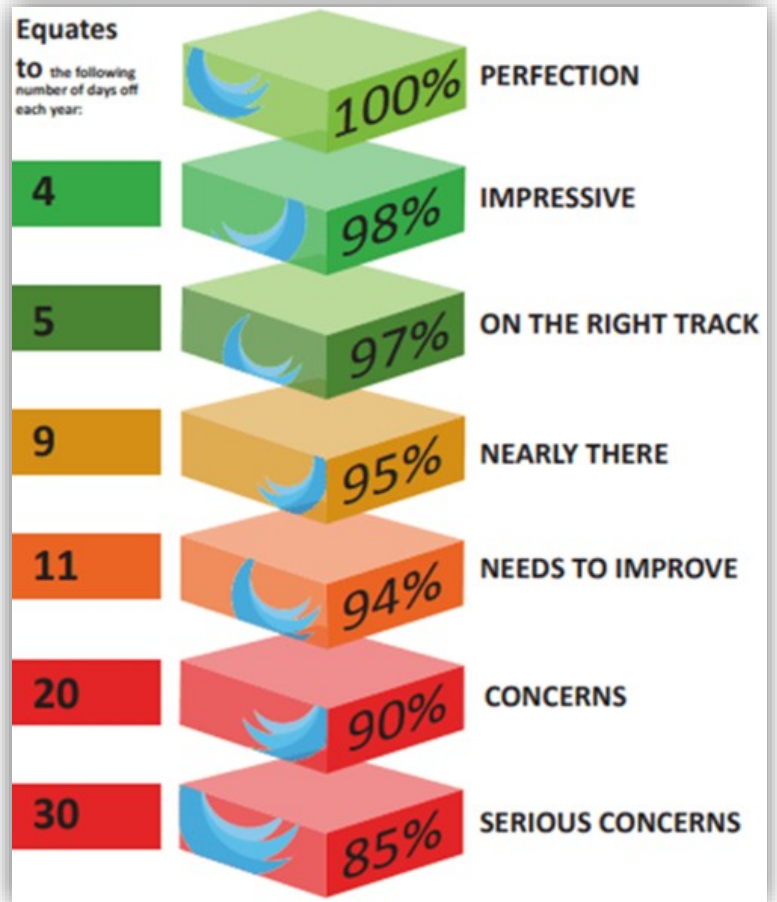

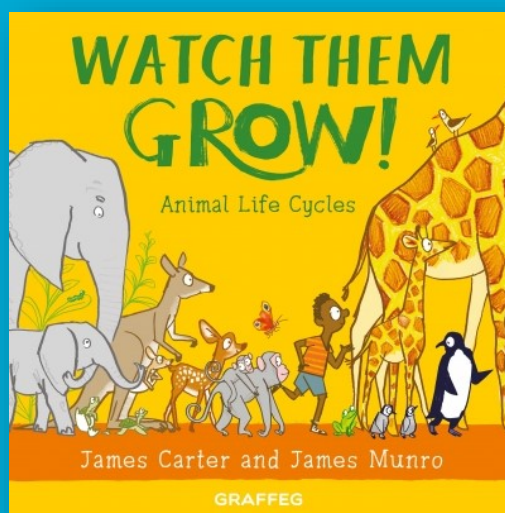

## Mrs Lampe Cullen's Recommended Reads

Watch them Grow! is a fun, rhyming text exploring some of nature's unique life cycles, including frogs, starlings, moths, turtles and more. Along with a short rhyming introduction and a contents page including each animal's Latin name, their class and location, each animal has its own short rhyme about their life cycle. Several information pages at the back of the book include more interesting facts about the names of many of the animals' young and an insight into how some of them are raised.



Take a tour of 20 unforgettable animal homes: unearth polar bear dens deep beneath the Arctic snow, soar above eagle nests as big as cars and marvel at the remoras that make themselves comfortable on the ocean's deadliest predators. Finding Home is a celebration of animals and their drive to survive no matter the odds - finding shelter in every nook and cranny on Earth, from the obvious to the unusual. With rich, vivid non-fiction storytelling and arresting illustrations, this is an essential collection for anyone fascinated by animals and the wild ways they live.
