Mrs Lampe Cullen's Recommended Reads



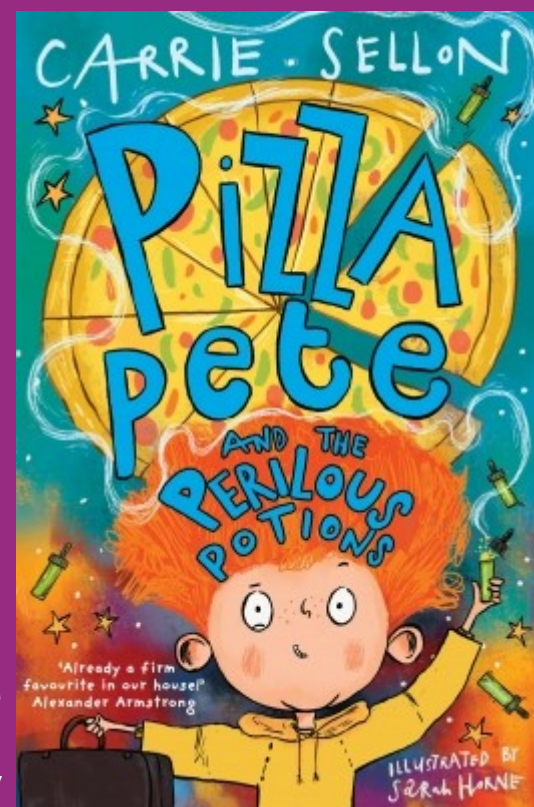
Explore the wacky world of Jason Korsner and Max Low's zoo in this hilarious, rhyming picture book.
