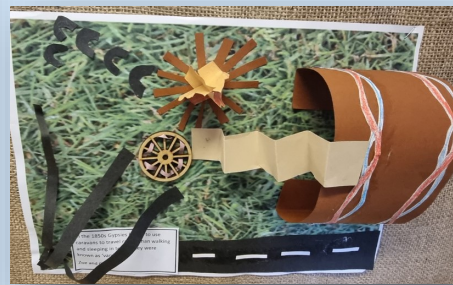

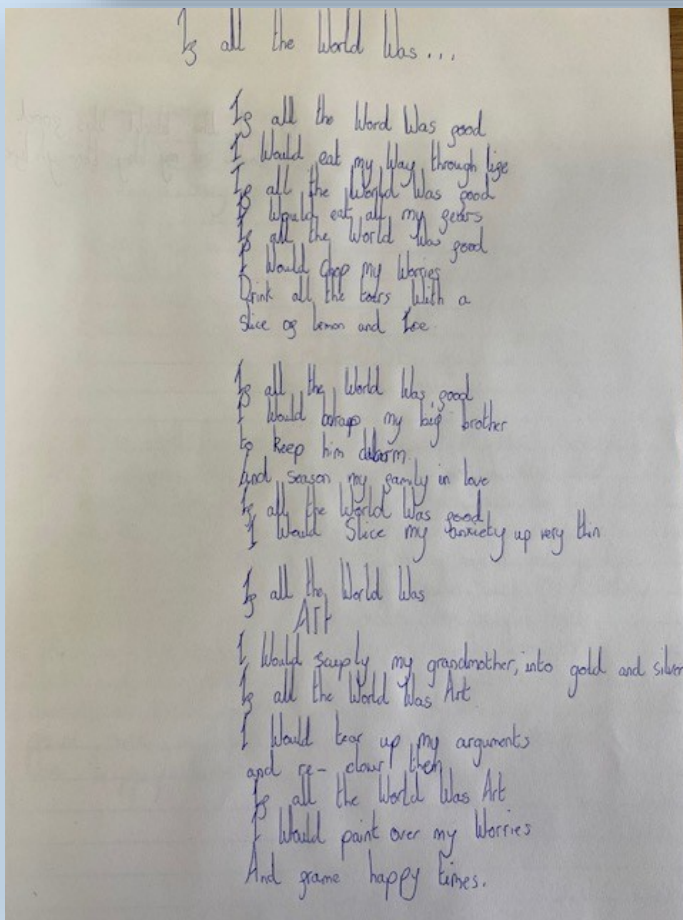

This was written by a group of Year 5 children after reading Joseph Coelho's poem "If all the world was paper".

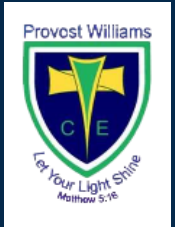
As Year 4 will all be aware, Mrs Aguera has been unwell and has not been in school recently.

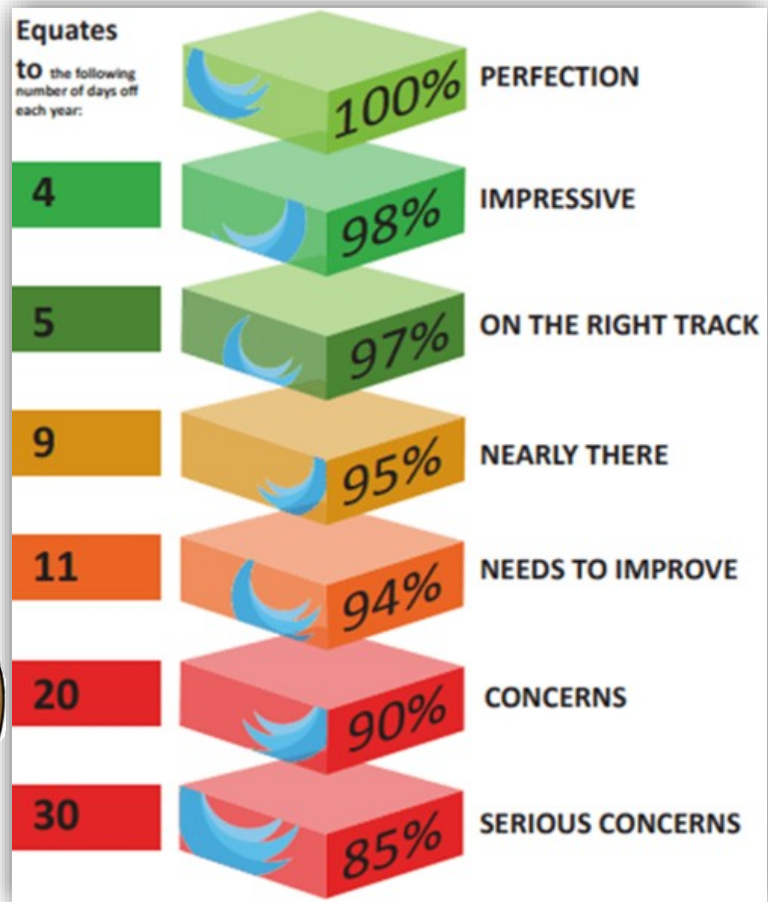

Plans for Sports Day 2023, Tuesday 4th July

Children should arrive at school in their PE kit on Tuesday 4th July, hair tied back and not wearing any jewellery.

Races will include sprints and fun races, with the emphasis on supporting each other and good sportsmanship.

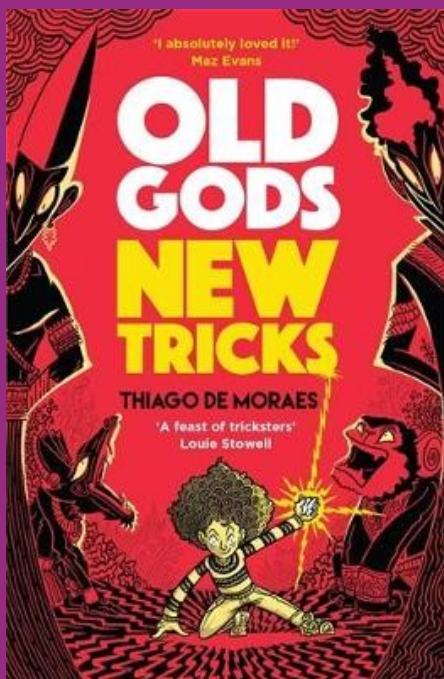
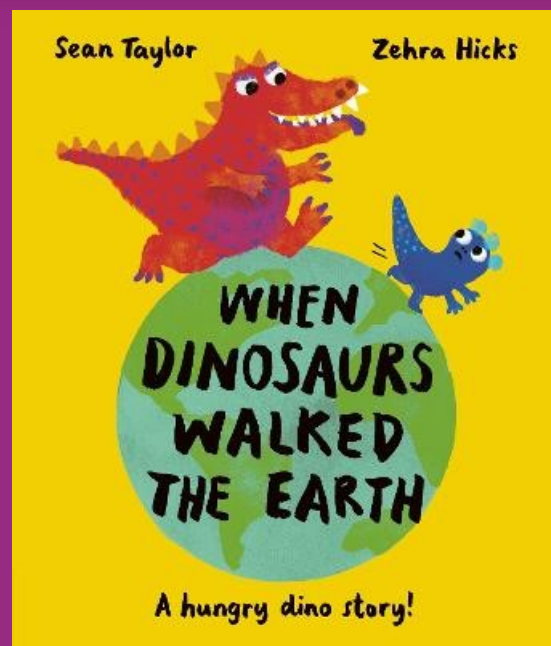

Mrs Lampe Cullen's Recommended Reads

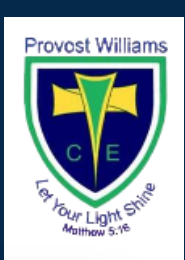

Bikeability – Summer Holiday Courses 2023



LEVEL 1 TRAINING FOR PUPILS IN SCHOOL YEARS 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6:

This training teaches basic cycle control skills in a safe environment away from traffic and will be run at Harris C of E Academy's Sport Centre in Rugby. Children **must be able** to cycle independently (no stabilisers) before coming on the course. Training takes place outside & children must be dressed appropriately in warm, weather proof clothing with gloves recommended, or with adequate sun protection.

Course 1: Tuesday 1st August 2023 from 9:30am to 11:45am

Cost: £0 This course is **fully funded** by DfT & Warwickshire County Council through the Bikeability grant. Training is based on the National Standard on behalf of DfT.

LEVEL 2 TRAINING FOR PUPILS IN SCHOOL YEARS 5, 6 & 7:

This training prepares students for cycling on the public highway for short journeys such as from home to school and will be run from Harris C of E Academy's Sports Centre in Rugby. It is **strongly recommended** that children complete the Level 1 course before attempting Level 2. Training takes place outside & children must be dressed appropriately as detailed above for level 1.

Course Dates (over 2 days. Both days must be attended):

Course 1: Wednesday 2nd August 2023 & Thursday 3rd August 2023 from 9:15am to 12:30pm

Cost: £0 This course is **fully funded** by DfT & Warwickshire County Council through the Bikeability grant. Training is based on the National Standard on behalf of DfT.

Early booking is essential as places are strictly limited and will be filled on a first come first served basis.

**** Closing deadline for bookings is Friday 14th July 2023. None will be accepted after this date. ****

Courses will only run if minimum numbers are reached. Children will need to have their own bicycle and helmet.

Please note that a completed booking form is required in order to secure your child's place.
