## Summer Term



Welcome back to the start of the Summer term. It was very nearly 'shorts' weather at the start of the week - but April is definitely living up to its reputation. We have lots to look forward to this term: the May Gala, Coronation celebration, Sports Day and I know a number of classes are looking at some exciting school trips for the children.

In school, we have been exploring how we can help support the children to pull on their previous learning to support them in class. Each lesson, children will be explicitly reminded and have the opportunity to recall their learning through our Teaching and Learning models.

It has been fantastic to see the children being challenged and the successes that come from that. We have also been revisiting our Behaviour for Learning policy and PWP Etiquette and will continue to expect all pupils to demonstrate these high expectations.

I thank you all for your continued support with this.

### Parent Questionnaire

Thank you to all the parents that took the time to complete the questionnaire. The results were good, but we acknowledge that the school is on a journey of improvement and this takes time.

Key takeaways were:

- Parents continue to state that their child feels safe in school and that their children are well looked after.
- There are some pockets in the school where behaviour does not meet expectation, however 23% more parents (compared to October Questionnaire) believe that the school deals effectively with bullying issues.
- A large majority of parents stated that the school responds well to any concerns raised.
- A large majority of parents would recommend the school to other parents, which is great.

There were two points which I would like to address which I hope will continue to improve the quality of education for children at PWP and so that parents have a better understanding of how your child is progressing at school.

1. The first point is about having valuable information out how well your child is progressing at school. Some parents said that they would like to more updates throughout the year. With this in mind, from September we will be sending home a mid-year progress update alongside the two parents evenings and a full end of year report at the end of the year.
2. The second point is around homework. No-one wants to be spending huge amounts of their evenings doing homework, when other things are important too, like playing outside and family time. However, where homework is set, there is an expectation that parents ensure children complete it. Reading will always be part of what is expected for all ages and other homework tasks will vary according to the age of the child. There are 3 options for parents to consider:-

Option 1. Maths and English based homework (grammar and punctuation) tasks plus reading a minimum of 3 times per week.

Option 2. Topic based 'Choice Board' homework where the children will select a different task to complete each week plus reading a minimum of 3 times a week.

3. Option 3. A combination of options 1 and 2.

I will share the outcome from the form once it has closed and then a decision will be made around what homework will look like in September.

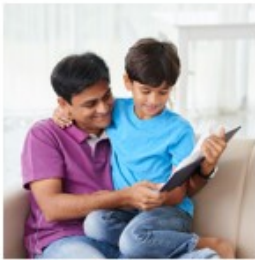

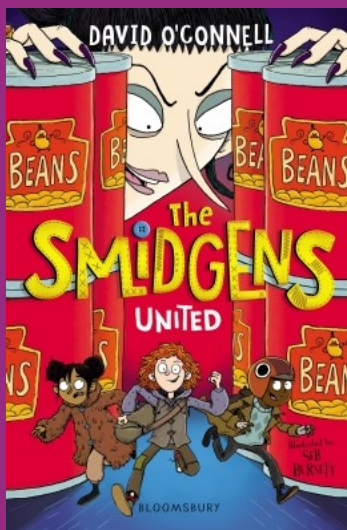
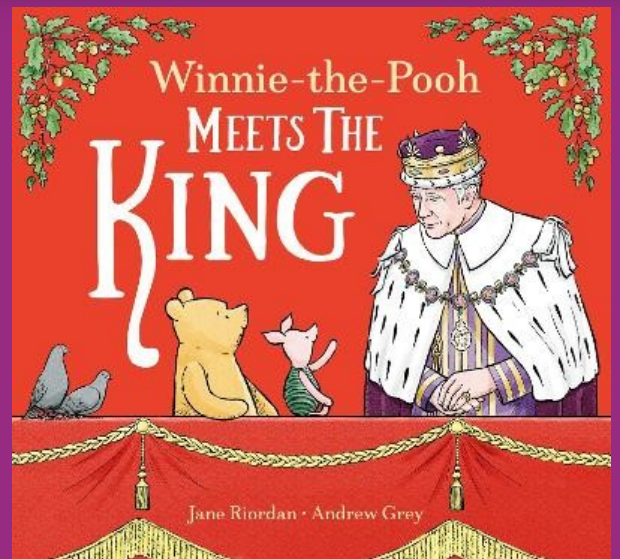
## Mrs Lampe Cullen's Recommended reads




When Winnie-the-Pooh and his friends go on an expedition to a Royal London Park they don't expect to find themselves in the middle of a royal adventure.
