I can't quite believe that we are heading into the penultimate week of the Autumn term.

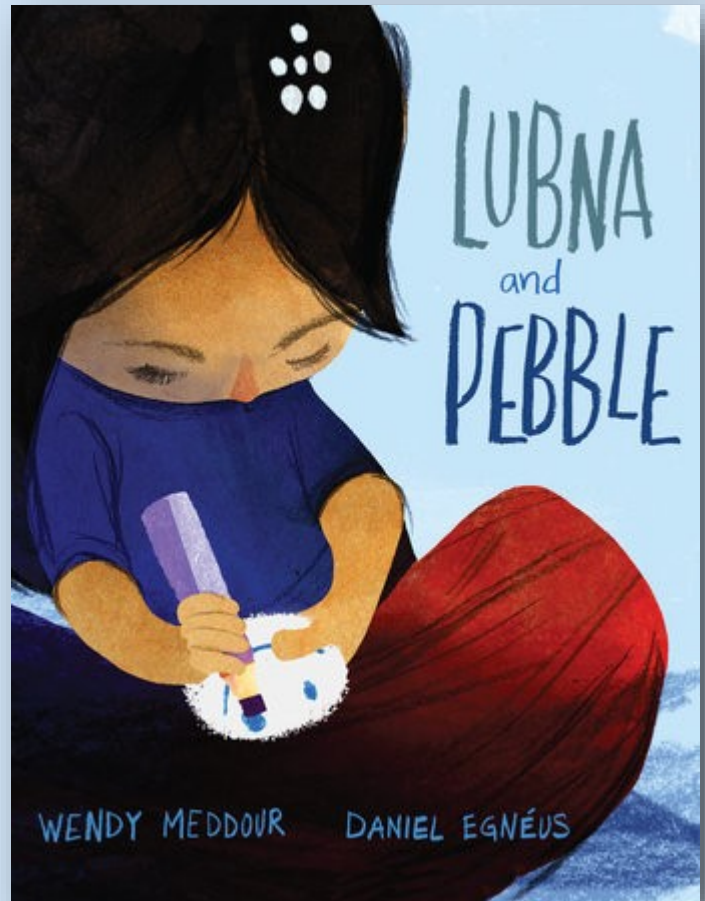
KS1 production rehearsals are now taking place in the hall which is lovely to hear from my office. You are all in for a real treat!

PROVOST WILLIAMS CHRISTMAS DAY

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Friday 16th December 2022, we will be having a 'Provost Williams Christmas day'. It will be our opportunity, as a school to celebrate a traditional Christmas day together as we can't be together on the 'actual day'.

Children should come to school in their pyjamas and bring clothes with them to change into. In traditional Christmas day style we will start by all having breakfast together in our pyjamas. This will be cereal, pain au chocolate and juice. If for any reason your child cannot have any of these, please speak to the class teacher and we can provide children with an alternative. Our Nursery children, will be joining in for their morning session, they can come for the session in their party clothes.
