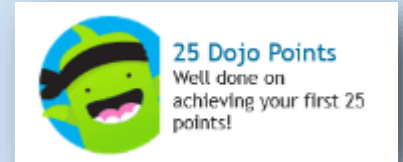
In-School Rewards

Most classes are now familiar with Dojo and how it works. We have had great feedback from parents on being able to see the learning that is taking place in school. This week, we introduced the next element to earning points on Dojo. When the children earn 25, 50, 75 or 100 Dojo points they will be given a special ticket which will allow them to "buy" something from the reward shop.

There will be a variety of rewards that the children will be able to select from and bring home to show you.

This week, we also launched our new "Going for Gold" system.

If your child achieves gold in the school day, they will earn 5 Dojo points and will come home with a certificate to share with you at home.

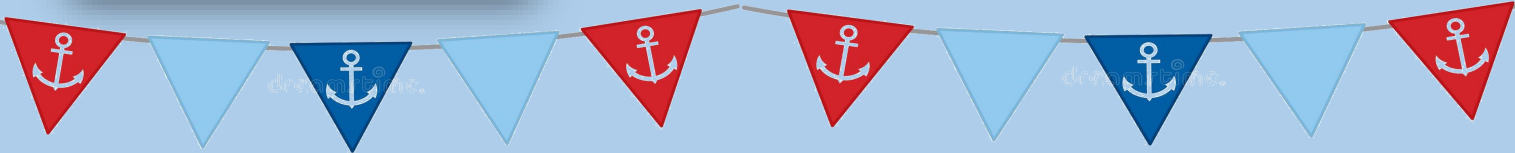


On 2nd December, we will be saying a fond farewell to a much loved member of staff as she leaves our school to sail the seven seas!

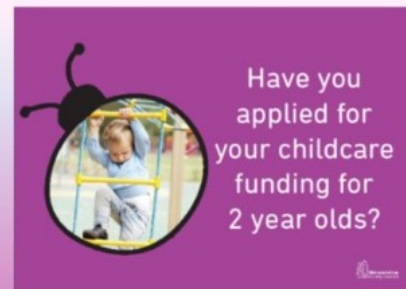
