### **Equalities statement**

- We expect all pupils to follow our uniform policy. Parents should communicate with us if they need further support with this.

## **Uniform:**

### **BOYS**

Royal blue sweatshirt (logo not necessary) – where children still have the navy jumper this can be worn until it needs replacing.

White polo shirt (no logo required)

Grey school trousers- no jeans or chinos

Black school shoes.

Grey socks

### **GIRLS**

Royal blue sweatshirt (logo not necessary) – where children still have the navy jumper this can be worn until it needs replacing.

White polo shirt (no logo required)

Grey skirt or pinafore

Grey formal trousers (not bootleg)

White/Grey socks (not trainer socks)

Black school shoes.

### **PE/Games kit**

Polo Shirt (Green) with school logo

Plain Royal Blue Hoody

Navy shorts

Black pumps for indoor activities

Trainers for outdoor activities

Dark coloured jogging bottoms or leggings for Key Stage 2 children is desirable for outside P.E. during the colder weather

### **Swimming**

Appropriate swimwear will be required by pupils for lessons taken at the leisure centre.

### **Jewellery**

Due to Health and Safety reason, no jewellery should be worn other than simple stud Earrings and a watch.

### **School Bags**

Children do not require large school bags or additional equipment. All basic equipment e.g. pencils, rulers, handwriting pens, colouring pencils is provided by school and must not be brought into school. Children can have a small school bag for their reading book and homework to be taken home and brought into school.

Reception and Year 1 children should have a small, slim book bag (which can fit inside their drawer). Please let us know if you would like support with one of these.

### **Lunchboxes**

Lunchboxes should be named, stored on the year group lunchbox trolley and taken home every day.

**Water bottles**

Water bottles should be named and they will be kept in the classroom other than when taken outside or to the hall for sports activities. Children are encouraged to drink water and should not bring other drinks into school.

**Assistance**

School expectation is that all pupils will be able to wear their uniform with pride. If for any reason, issues are encountered purchasing uniform, please come and speak to us in confidence in the school office or contact Mrs Lampe Cullen.
