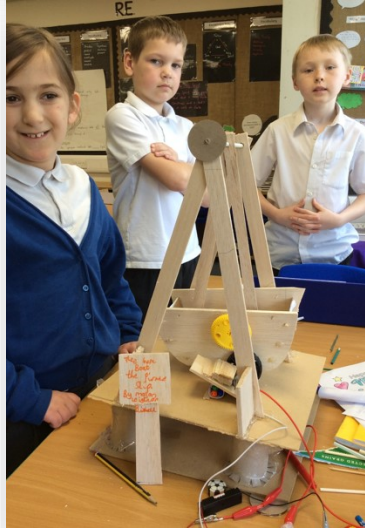
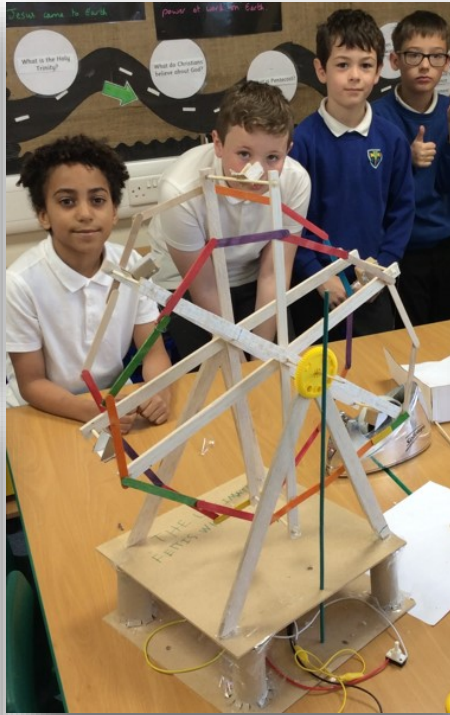

Year 2 made their own pizza during DT Week. They smelt delicious!





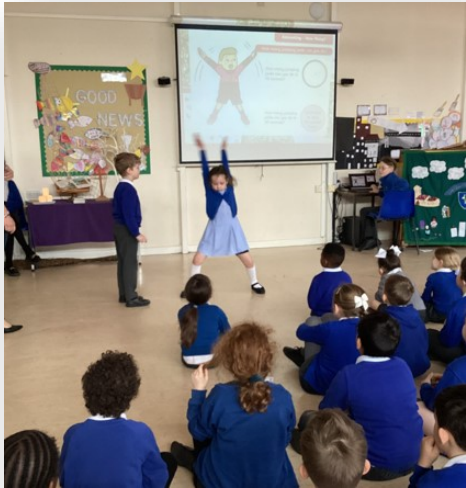
Wilde Class and Simon created the most amazing playgrounds for DT Week. Some of them had cogs and gears!



Year 6 have been working on adapting T Shirts and Year 1 have made their own sock puppets.



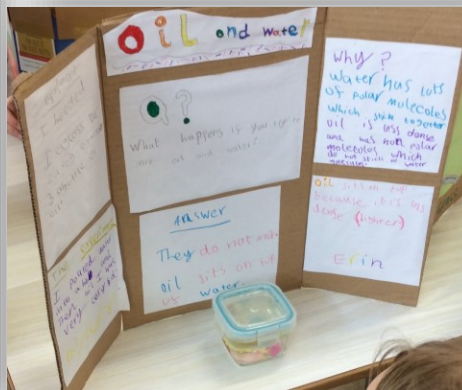
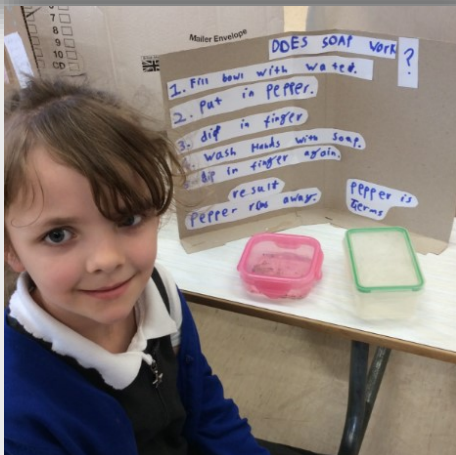
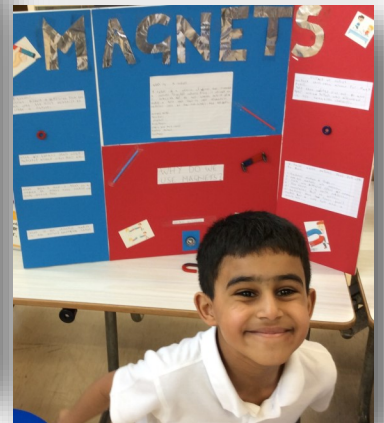
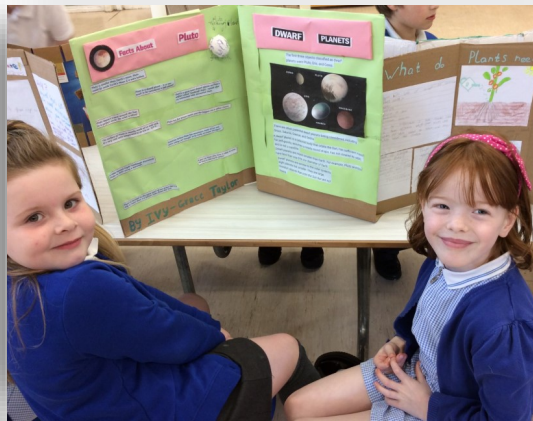
World Maths Day

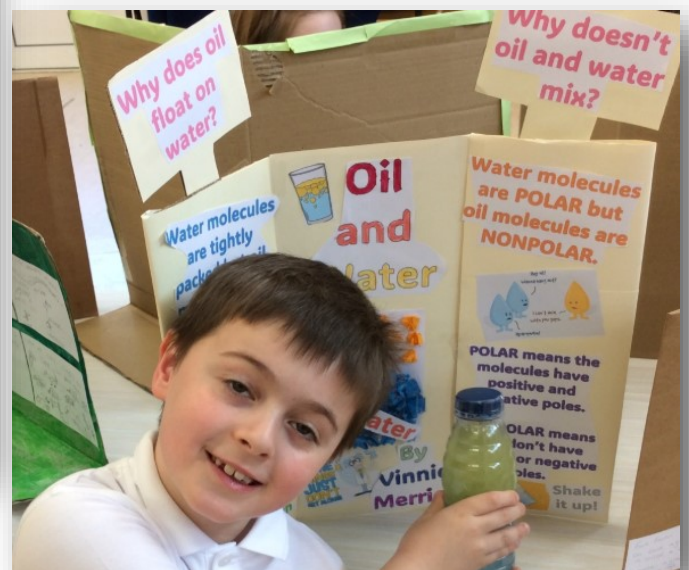
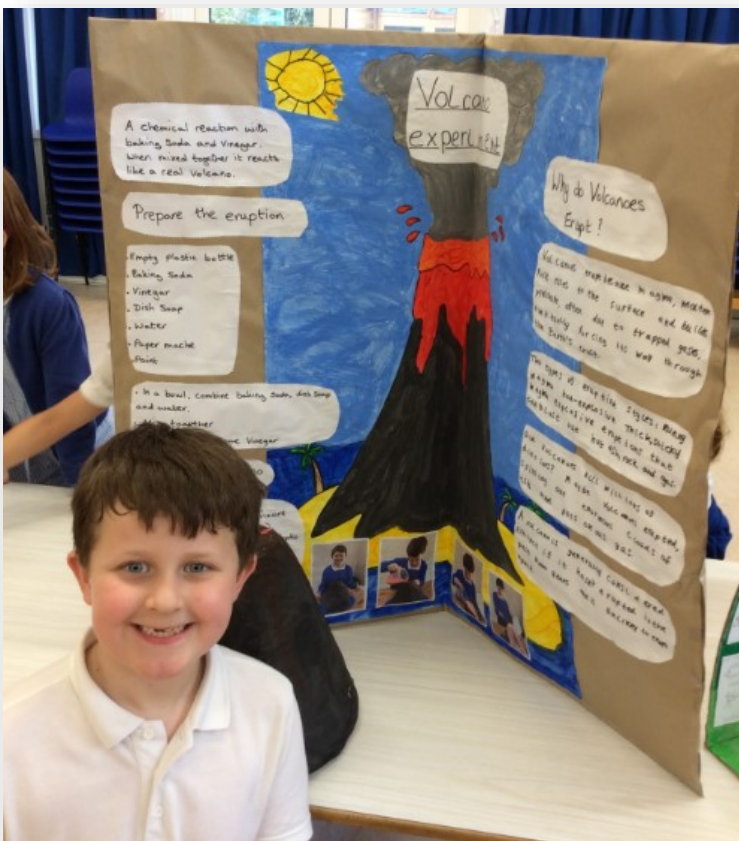
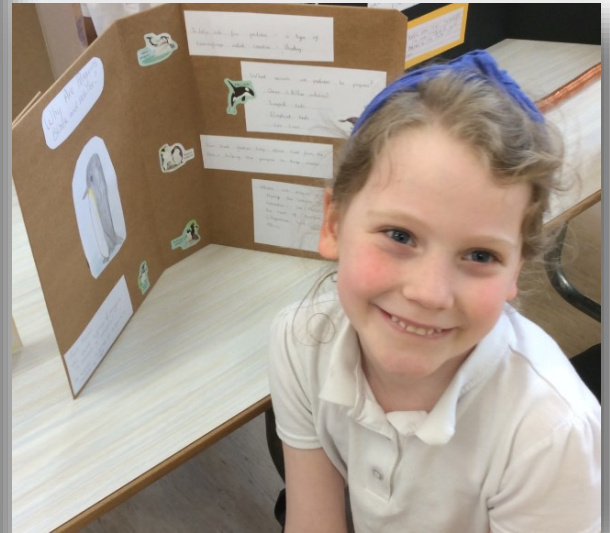
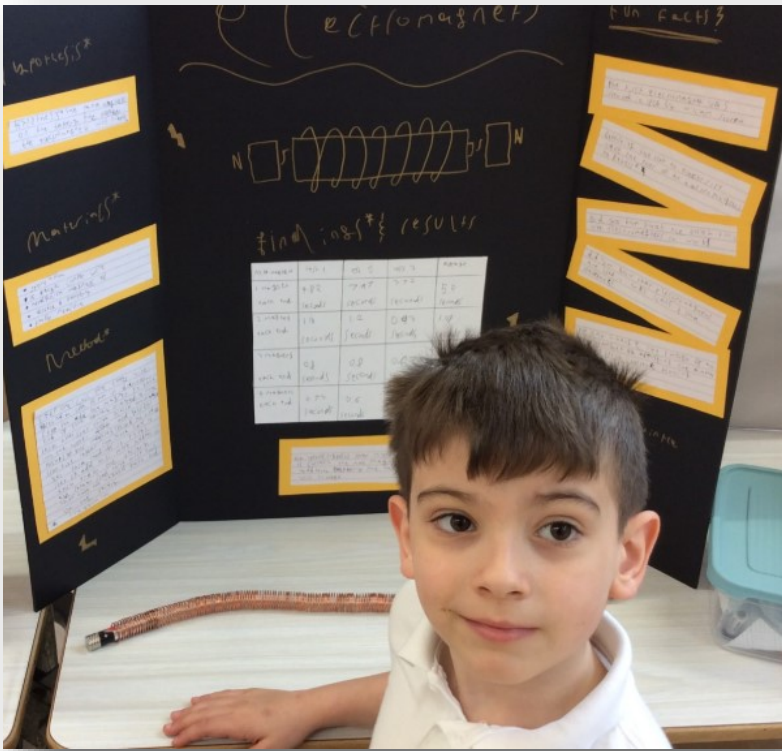

Well done to all of the children who managed excellent attendance last week and to the 76 who managed the whole 4 weeks.

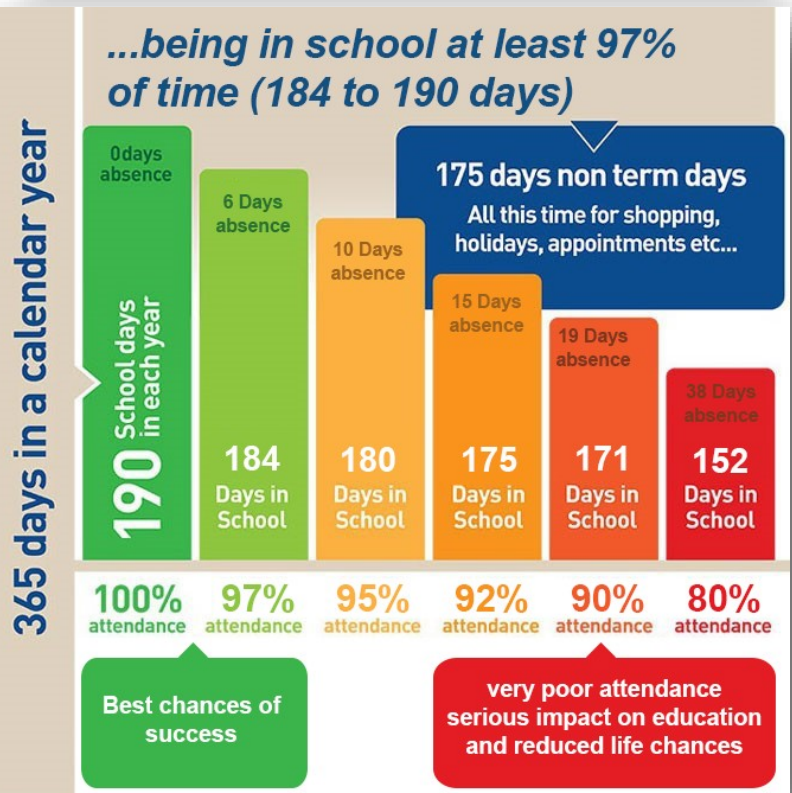
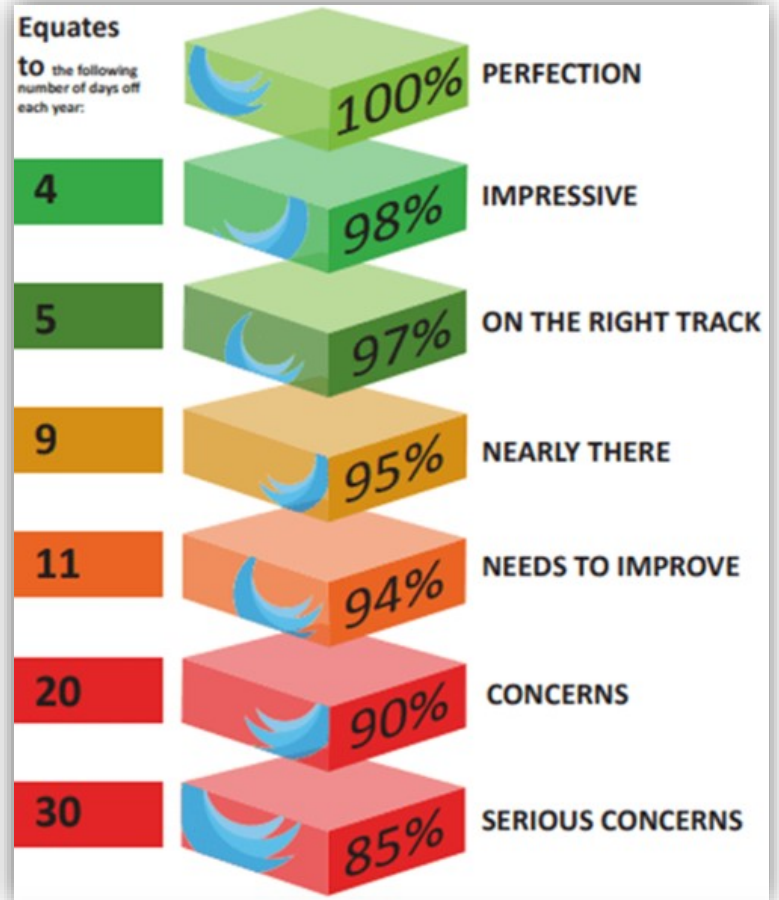

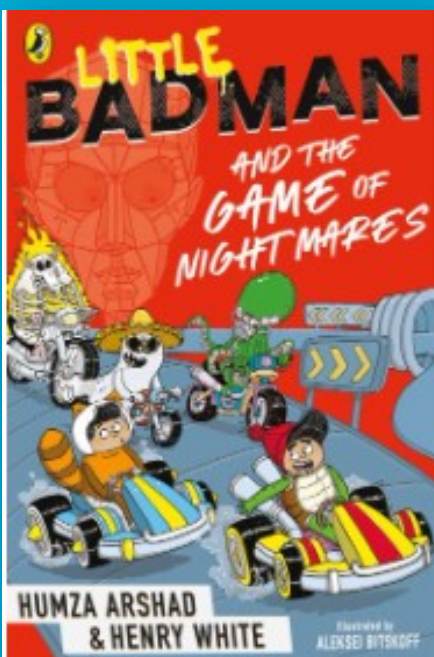




Miss Cullen's Recommended Reads

I am very passionate about animals and would love to take your furry friends on a walk it also supports my dream of competing in a world competition

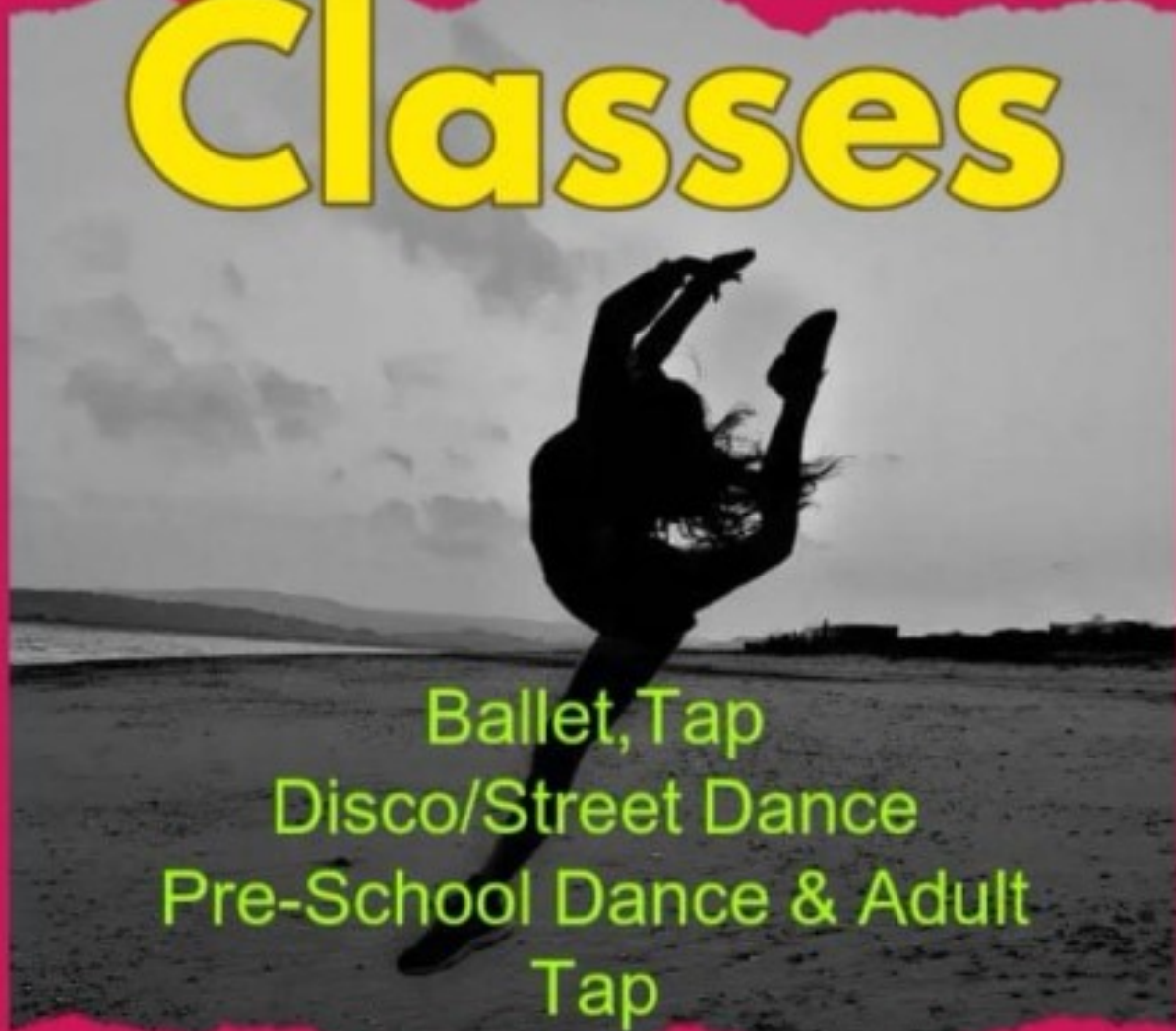
